Awards will be based on

- Minimum grade point average of 2.5 for undergraduates and 3.0 for graduate students
- Community involvement
- Participation in co-curricular and/or extra-curricular activities
- Reflective essay

- Juniors
- Seniors
- Graduate Students

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

To be considered for one of the awards, you must submit a completed application packet either by dropping it off at the Center for Student Leadership, Rm. 008 Rhatigan Student Center, or by mailing it to the address below. All applications must be typewritten, double-spaced in 12 point font with no less than one inch margins and contain the following:

- Application Coversheet (see page 2)
- Student Application (see page 3).
- Essay (see page 4 for essay instructions)
- At least one picture (digital or print, although digital is preferred) of the applicant, preferably a picture in which the applicant is engaged in activity or receiving award. Photos can also be sent via email in .jpg format to gina.lee@wichita.edu. The photos will be used in a presentation at the Student Leadership Recognition Ceremony on April 29, 2007.
- Applications must include the original, as well as 4 copies.

- How do you lead and served others?
- What have you learned through participation in co-curricular activities that has led to your personal or academic growth?
