**PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS AND COURSE SEQUENCE**

In order that you have the best possible preparation for each course, be sure to complete the prerequisites prior to taking each course.

- CESP 701(3): Introduction to Educational Research (Prerequisites: none)
- CESP 704(3): Introduction to Educational Statistics (Prerequisites: none)
- CESP 707(1): Child Abuse and Neglect (Prerequisites: none)
- CESP 728(3): Theories of Human Development (Prerequisites: CESP 334, PSY 334 or equivalent and CESP 701 or equivalent or instructor consent)
- CESP 802(1): Introduction to Interaction Process (Prerequisite: Counseling major or department consent. To be taken concurrently with CESP 804)<sup>a</sup>
- CESP 803(3): Counseling Theory (Prerequisites: Admission to the counseling or school psychology program or instructor consent)
- CESP 804(3): Principles and Philosophy of Counseling (Prerequisites: Admission to the counseling program or instructor consent); to be taken concurrently with CESP 802

OR  
**CESP Elective**

- CESP 815(3): Career Development (Prerequisites: CESP 803 or 804 or instructor consent)
- CESP 821(3): Multicultural Issues in Counseling (Prerequisites: CESP 701, 803 or 804, or instructor consent)
- CESP 822(3): Assessment in Counseling (Prerequisites: CESP 701 and 704; CESP 803 or 804)
- CESP 824(3): Techniques of Counseling (Prerequisites: CESP 728, 803, 804, 821, 822 or department consent)<sup>a</sup>
- CESP 825(3): Group Counseling Techniques (Prerequisites: CESP 804; CESP 803 or concurrent enrollment in 803; department consent)<sup>a</sup>
- CESP 835(3): Psychopathology and DSM-IV (Prerequisites: CESP 728, 840 [School Psychology students only] or department consent)
- CESP 837(2): Family Issues in Counseling (Prerequisites: Graduate standing)
- CESP 845(3): Professional School Counseling (Prerequisites: CESP 701, 704, 803 and 804, or instructor consent)<sup>b</sup>
- CESP 856(3): Counseling Practicum (Prerequisites: CESP 824 within the last calendar year, coordinator consent, and counseling major or department consent)<sup>a</sup>
- CESP 857(3): Professional and Ethical Issues (Prerequisites: CESP 803, 821, 822 or instructor consent)

If you are pursuing the thesis option, you must also take the following:

- CESP 823(3): Experimental Design in Educational Research (Prerequisite: CESP 704 or instructor consent)
- CESP 860(1): Seminar in Research Problems
- CESP 875(2): Master's Thesis (Prerequisite: CESP 860)
- CESP 876(2): Master's Thesis (Prerequisites: CESP 860, 875)
