

**Scholarships for Study Abroad through the Barton School of Business  
(Fall and Spring semesters- \$800)  
(Summer semester- \$400)**

*Criteria for Scholarship Recipients:*

- Student must be declared business major
- Student must study abroad at one of our exchange partner universities (see list on our website)
- Minimum GPA requirement is 3.0
- Student will be asked to complete the study abroad scholarship application form and submit 2 references, personal statement, official transcript and resume
- Student must complete the study abroad application process and be accepted to study at the exchange partner university
- Recipients of the scholarships will be required to complete volunteer service prior to their semester abroad through the Business Advising Center (see below for details on this requirement)

**Deadlines to apply:**

**Fall semester- March 1<sup>st</sup>    Spring semester- August 1<sup>st</sup>    Summer semester- January 5<sup>th</sup>**

**Business School Scholarship for Study Abroad- Volunteer Requirement**

Recipients of this scholarship will be required to volunteer in the Business Advising Center for a total of 80 to 120 hours prior to departing for their study abroad program. Typically, the hours will be divided up throughout the semester so that students volunteer 5 to 10 hours per week on an “as needed basis.” Students will be assigned duties each week by Ann Burger or another staff member in the advising center. The schedule for work hours is flexible and can be adjusted to fit the needs of the student. Below is a list of such duties:

- Maintain bulletin boards in Clinton Hall
- Coordinate International Buddy System
- Help organize events for International Students
- Help with study abroad projects
- Make copies as needed for various events and/or projects
- Other miscellaneous duties for the business advising center
