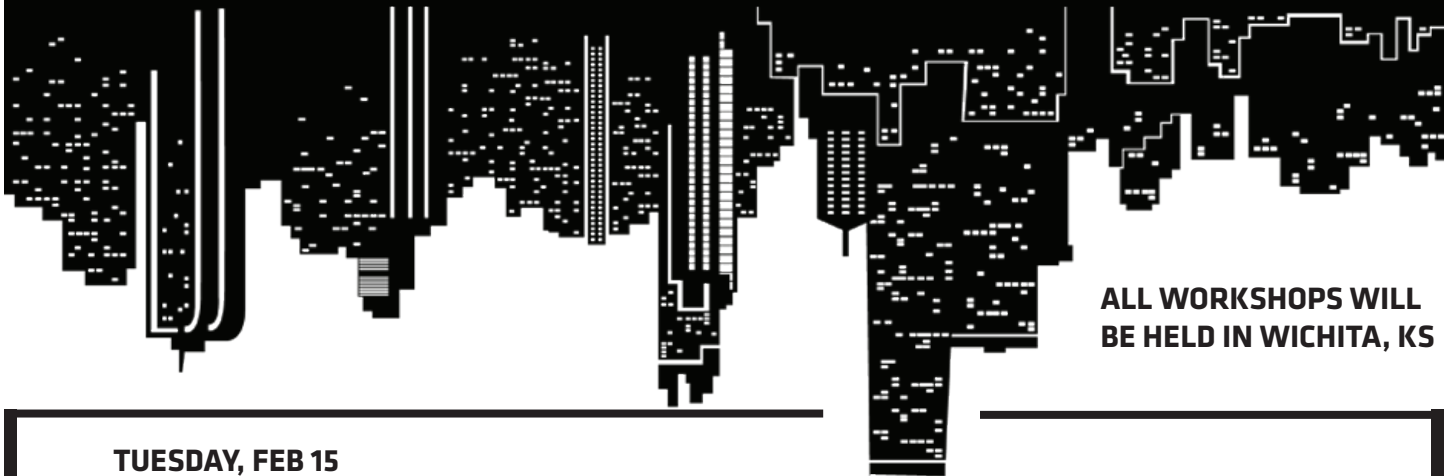

TUESDAY, FEB 15

Roadmap to Starting a Nonprofit

This workshop will provide an overview of how to build organizations which qualify for IRS nonprofit status. Workshop topics will include characteristics of well-constructed charitable organizations, questions for prospective nonprofits, and a review of primary tasks and government requirements. Building shared leadership from the start of your effort will also be discussed. Presenters will include Susan Whitfield-Lungren, attorney and nonprofit developer.

TUESDAY, APRIL 19

Grant Development

This workshop looks at the current state of grant funding and how grants are given. We discuss Grant Development and that writing grants is more than putting pen to paper. Participants learn how to design a fundable grant project and how to write a true problem statement with reliable sources of data that support the project. Once participants have defined the problem statement, they learn how to write their project as the solution. In addition, participants learn to write a focused on the client, concise, and enthusiastic proposal and learn the details to grant budgets. They leave with the tools and resources to strengthen their grant project.

Social Media for Nonprofits and Coalitions
