Dr. & Mrs. Robert V. Christian & Dr. Robert V. Christian, Jr. Scholarship

- Awarded annually to full or part-time entering freshmen.
- Must be a declared chemistry major.

E.W. "Pete" Armstrong Endowed Scholarship

- Awarded annually to full or part-time LAS juniors with 20 or more hours of chemistry.
- Must be a declared chemistry major.
- Must have a 3.25 GPA or better.
- Awarded on the basis of scholarly aptitude and achievement, not financial need.
- Renewed annually until completion of BS in Chemistry or two years, whichever comes first. Student must apply for renewal and continue to satisfy scholarship criteria.

W. Mack Barlow Chemistry Scholarship

- Awarded annually to a full or part-time LAS student(s).
- Must be a declared chemistry major.
- Consideration will be given to academic merit.
- Awards will be made with regard to financial need. **(Must complete Financial Aid section of LAS Scholarship Application form.)**
- May be renewed automatically based upon satisfactory academic achievements.

Jerry Cohlma LAS/Chemistry Scholarship

- Awarded annually to full or part-time LAS student(s) with preference given to chemistry major(s).
- Consideration given to academic performance, potential and leadership qualities, not financial need.
- Renewed automatically if the student(s) maintains satisfactory academic progress.

Fletcher-McKinley Endowed Scholarship

- Awarded annually to a full or part-time LAS student(s).
- Must be a declared chemistry major.
- Renewable if the student(s) maintains satisfactory academic progress.

Frank Clifford Malone Research Scholarship Fund

- Awarded annually to a full-time LAS student enrolled in a minimum of 12 credit hours, less for summer.
- Must be a declared chemistry major.
- Must be involved in a research project in the area of organic chemistry during the award semester.
- Consideration given to high school performance, college potential and leadership qualities, not financial need.
- Awarded on a semester basis.
- Renewable if the student maintains satisfactory academic progress during the previous semester of the award.

Charles & Nina Kirby-Jones Biochemistry Scholarship

- Awarded annually to an upper-class, LAS, full-time student(s) with a declared Field Major in Biochemistry (through either the Biological Sciences or Chemistry departments). Awarded in honor of Dr. Hazel Branch and Dr. Lloyd McKinley who inspired the Joneses during their undergraduate years.
- Must have completed Biology 210, 211, Chemistry 211 and 212 (or equivalent courses) by the end of the spring semester of application.
- Must submit a one page essay discussing your motivation to pursue a career in biochemistry.
- Renewable if the student(s) maintains satisfactory academic progress.

Charles M. Buess Chemistry/Business Program Scholarship Fund

- Awarded annually to one (or two) student(s) with a declared Field Major in Chemistry/Business.
- Sole consideration given to those showing an interest and ability in chemistry.
- Renewed automatically if the student(s) maintains satisfactory academic progress.
