

HOW TO APPLY TO THE EARLY ADMISSION OPTION
WSU SCHOOL OF NURSING

Information for students planning to begin their freshmen year of college fall 2010

1. Complete an application for admission to Wichita State University:
admissions.wichita.edu
2. Once you have been fully admitted to WSU, you are eligible to apply for early admission to the nursing program if you have qualifying ACT scores or college coursework in English and Math. Contact the School of Nursing at 316-978-5708 or 800-516-0290 to determine your eligibility and receive an application.
3. Complete the Early Admission application. Choose either a 4-semester option (enter nursing program fall 2012) or a 5-semester option (enter nursing program spring 2013.) If you need assistance in deciding what option would be best for you, contact Christina Folkerts, Early Admission Advisor, at 316-978-5708.
4. Applications are accepted and processed on a first come, first served basis.
Students are encouraged to complete an application as soon as they meet eligibility requirements. Students inquiring after 30 spaces are filled will be considered on a space-available basis and may be offered a place on the Early Admission Option wait list.
5. Early Admission candidates should schedule their Shocker Connection advising appointment **before June 1, 2010**. You will enroll for your first semester classes at this meeting.
6. Acceptance to the Early Admission Option becomes official once you have enrolled for fall 2010 classes at Wichita State University and have signed the Early Admission statement of agreement.
