- **Admission into Teacher Education** - Completed application packet
- **Admission to Student Teaching** - a) Satisfactory accomplishment of content-area, standard-driven assessments, b) "B" in ISAM courses, c) "S" in all pre-student teaching courses, d) 2.5 GPA (overall, WSU and content) and e) Completed application packet with yearly negative TB test.
- **Exit from Student Teaching** - a) Completion of: student teaching with "B" or better and successful completion of the student teaching seminar, b) 2.5 GPA (overall and WSU), c) Successful completion of all degree requirements, d) Final Student Teaching Supervisor Evaluation Form.
- **Degree Completion** - a) 2.5 GPA (overall and WSU), and b) Meets all degree requirements
- **Licensure Recommendation** - a) Passes common assessments, b) At least 80% mastery on Teacher Work Sample, c) PLT with 161 or better, d) Praxis II content test(s) passed, and e) Licensure application
