

Fall 2009 MSEE Exit Exam

The EE MS Exit Exam for the fall 2009 semester will be held on Friday, November 20, from 1:30 to 4:30 pm, in room 307 NIAR. If you plan to take this exam, you must sign up for it by Friday October 30.

A signup sheet will be posted in the EECS Office, Jabara Hall 249. When you sign the sheet, you will need to indicate the two areas in which you plan to be tested.

The entire Exit Exam is **closed-book** and **closed-notes**. Students will be allowed to bring four 8 ½" by 11" sheets of paper to the exam. Notes can be written on both sides of each sheet.

EE students in the course work option, admitted prior to fall 2009, must pass an Exit Exam to fulfill their graduation requirements. The Exit Exam for the course work option will be offered once each semester. Each student will be allowed three (3) hours to complete the Exam, which covers two (2) areas that have been determined by the student prior to the date of the exam. To qualify to take the exam during a given semester, the student must have completed eighteen (18) hours of course work by the end of the semester in which the exam is taken. In the event of an unsuccessful attempt, the student may retake the exam in a subsequent semester with the option of selecting new areas, or the student may transition to the new 36 hour criteria, which does not require an exit exam. Only two exam attempts are allowed.

The available areas with relevant courses are:

- 1) Software Engineering: CS 738
- 2) Communications: EE 726 and EE 754
- 3) Control: EE 777a and EE 792
- 4) Signal Processing: EE 782
- 5) Power Systems: EE 598 and EE 697
- 6) Computer Networking: CS 736 and CS 764
- 7) Information Security: CS 765 and CS 766
- 8) Device-Level Integrated Circuits: EE 691 and EE 791
