Plus, when you live with us, there are no extra bills.

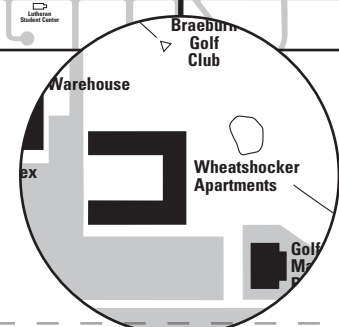
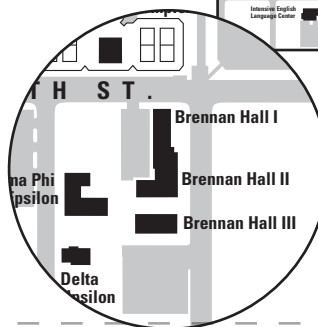
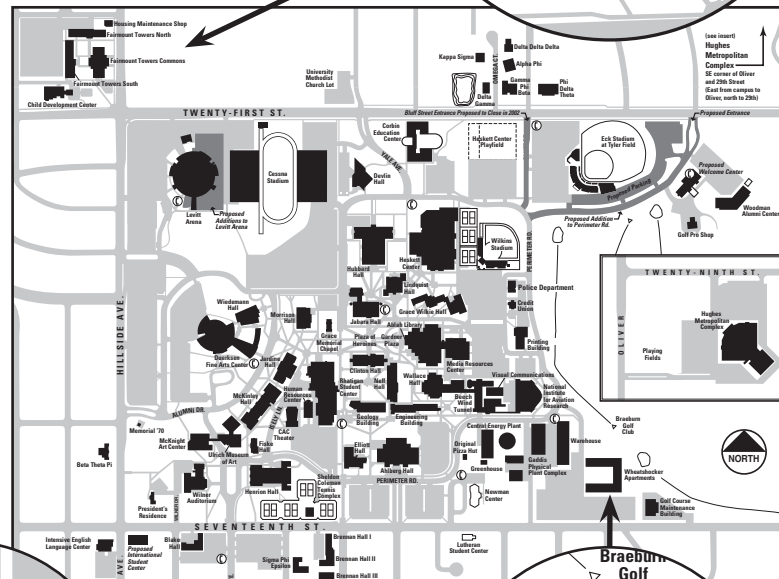
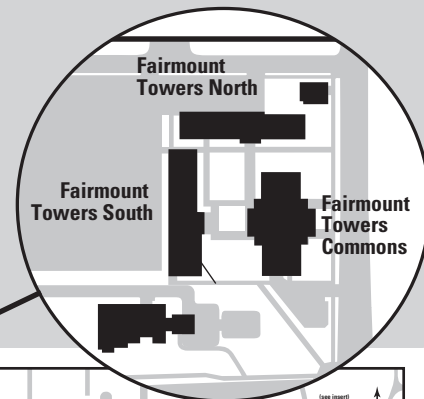
**All rates include gas, water, electricity, local phone service, Ethernet and wireless connections, cable, and food.**

There are 19 all-you-can-eat meals served in the Fairmount Café each week (breakfast, lunch, and dinner during the

school week and brunch and dinner on the weekends). If you miss a meal during the day you can replace it by eating at Late Night dining offered Sunday through Thursday. With a 19 meal plan you can eat all 19 meals served during the week. With a 15 meal plan you can eat 15 out of the 19 meals served ... and so on.

All meal plans include either \$200 or \$300 Shocker Dollars—a part of your meal plan that we have set aside for flexible spending. Residents of Brennan Hall and Wheatshocker Apartments may choose any meal plan. Shocker Dollars can be used at Copperfields and Fastbreak in the Rhatigan Student Center, Blimpie's in Hubbard Hall, Book and Bean in Ablah Library, the Wheatshocker Market, and Fairmount Café.

To find out exactly what it will cost to live on campus, just choose an option that meets your needs and get the rate, it's that simple.



## Application Procedures—Three steps to a new crib.

- 1 **Sign and return a completed white copy of the application/contract.**  
The contract is a legally binding agreement and while we promise not to pull any funny stuff, you'd better read it anyway.
- 2 **Keep the yellow copy of the application/contract for your records.**
- 3 **Mail the completed white copy of the application contract along with the \$50 application fee and \$200 prepayment for Fairmount/Brennan or \$100 deposit for Wheatshocker to:**

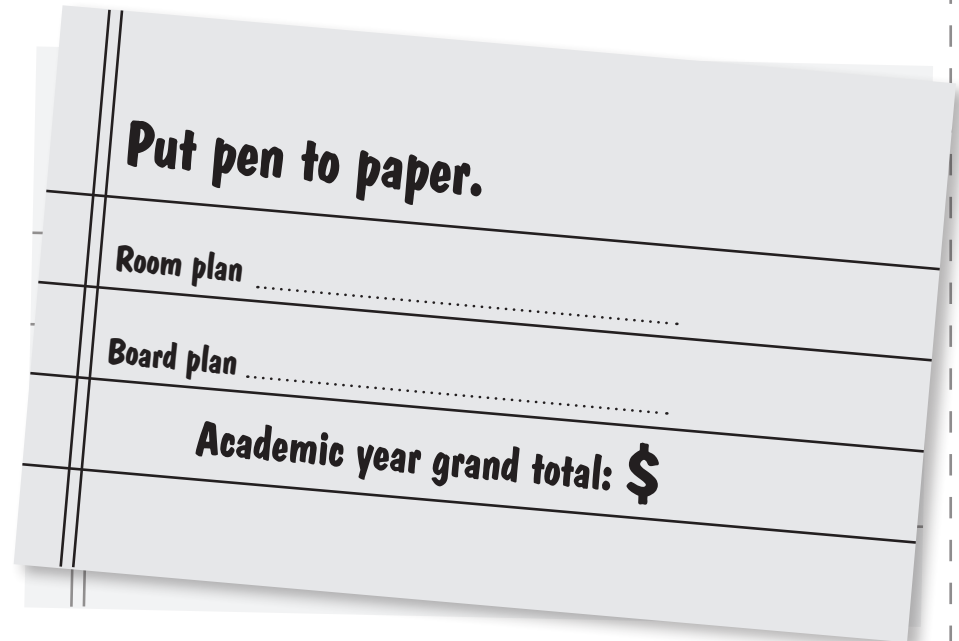

\* Semester room and board **payments** for **Fairmount Towers** and **Brennan Hall** are due in full before University registration and no later than the day before classes begin. Payment must be made even if financial assistance is not available at the time payment is due. Students who receive financial assistance must apply the money they receive toward tuition and fees first and then to room and board.

\* \* \* **Defining the crib.** A double room is a room with a roommate and up to 2 suitemates (no more than 4 people sharing a bathroom). A single room is a room with no roommate and up to 2 suitemates (no more than 3 people sharing a bathroom). A large room is a bit larger (see floor plans) than the standard room for the building.

\* \* \* **Take a friend, mom, or dad to lunch!** When you purchase a 19, 15, 10 or 5 board plan you get 10 free guest passes for the year.
