1. One (1) scholarship will be awarded annually to one (1) entering freshman or continuing recipient enrolled full time at Wichita State University, in the Fairmount College of Liberal Arts & Sciences, studying humanities.
 2. No recipient will be excluded from consideration based on race, religion, color, national origin, gender, age, sexual orientation, marital status, status as a Vietnam Era Veteran or disability.
 3. The scholarship will follow the recipient through four (4) years or until completion of the baccalaureate degree, whichever comes first. If the recipient leaves WSU before four (4) years, the entire award will begin with a new freshman student the following year.
 4. The scholarship recipient will be selected from among the annual Distinguished Scholarship Invitational participants.
 5. The award will be made without regard to financial need; however, should there be more than one qualified candidate, financial need should be considered.
 6. This scholarship is to cover full tuition, fees, books and the equivalent of on-campus room and board for a minimum of twelve (12) hours and not to exceed the amount available for awarding from this fund each year.
 7. Should there be an excess available for any of the funds beyond full tuition (minimum 12 hours), books and fees, and the equivalent of on-campus room and board, the excess will be reinvested in the principal of the fund until such time as it is sufficient to award an additional full tuition, books and fees, and room and board scholarship.
 8. The Scholarship Office, a department within the Division of Student Affairs of Wichita State University, will administer the scholarship and make the award. Recommendations submitted by the LAS Scholarship Committee will be given priority consideration.
 9. The scholarship will be renewed automatically so long as the student maintains satisfactory academic progress.
