Nov. 13 – Jan. 22	Spring web registration.
Nov. 13 – Jan. 22	Students must make payment arrangements at time of enrollment. Bills will NOT be mailed. Account information is available online beginning the week of November 13.
Nov. 13 – Jan. 22	On-line registration, in-person problem solving for registration problems, non-credit auditing, on-line and in-person payment.
Dec. 22 – Jan. 1	Holiday Shutdown – OFFICES CLOSED
January 2-13	Spring PRESESSION
January 2	Late registration for PRESESSION only.
January 4	Senior Citizen registration for pre-session only.
Beginning January 10	Excess financial aid deposited to students' bank accounts if you have entered your account information into your Student Account Suite.
January 11	Checks for excess financial aid mailed if you did not submit a Direct Deposit form. DOES WSU HAVE YOUR CORRECT ADDRESS?
January 15	Martin Luther King HOLIDAY – OFFICES CLOSED
January 16 (Tuesday)	First day of late registration. WEEKDAY AND EVENING CLASSES BEGIN.
January 18 (Thursday)	Senior citizen registration.
January 20-21	First day of Saturday/Sunday classes
January 22	Last day for late registration for most full-term courses.
<u>DROPS & ADDS</u> (also see "NOTE" below)	
January 22	Last day to add full semester classes or change sections of the same course.
<i>NOTE: Classes that are less than the whole semester in length and that begin after the first week of the semester, on-line registration continues every day through the first day of class.</i>	
January 29 (Monday)	LAST DAY FOR REGISTERED STUDENTS TO MAKE PAYMENT ARRANGEMENTS before late fees are placed on those accounts without payment arrangements.
January 29	Last day to drop a course and NOT have it appear on your record.
January 29	Last day to change your enrollment in a course from "credit" to "audit," via drop/adds.
January 29	<u>LAST DAY TO DROP AND RECEIVE A 100% TUITION REFUND FOR 16 WEEK COURSES.</u> No additional partial refunds provided.

Classes and credit workshops meeting for a period other than the regular academic term will refund according to the schedule online. Refund on non-credit workshops will be made only on cancellations received 48 hours prior to the time of the scheduled workshop.

February 12	20th day of classes—Official Regents' reporting date.
February 12	GRAD students: Last day to file an "Application for Degree" (for Spring 2018) online.
March 5-9	Most first 8-week courses end this week.
March 7	Mid-semester point.
March 7	Tentative date for Summer and Fall 2018 Schedule of Courses to be available online.
March 16	Mid-term grade reports available to students online.
March 19-25	Spring BREAK – no classes
March 30	Last day to officially withdraw from a course with a "W." <i>Note: This deadline is different, but proportionately equivalent, for courses that are less than the full semester in length. It is based upon the length of the course, which is the elapsed time from the first class meeting to the last, regardless of how many class meetings there are during that time. The day that marks completion of two-thirds of the course's length is the deadline for withdrawal with a "W." Should that fall on a Saturday or Sunday, the deadline is the next business day.</i>
April 2	Tentative date for Summer and Fall early registration to begin.
April 13	GRAD students: If graduating this Spring, last day to submit Request to Schedule Oral Defense
April 16	Late fees are placed on delinquent accounts
April 27	GRAD students: last day to hold oral defense if graduating at end of Spring.
May 3	Last day of classes.
May 4	Study Day GRAD students: IF graduating at end of this Spring: Last day to remove incomplete grades. Last day to submit ETD. Last day to report completion of terminal program requirements. Last day to clear unmet financial obligations. Last day to report oral defense results.
May 5-10	Final examinations—see schedule online.

May 21	Spring grades available through Self Service
July 15	Spring diplomas available.
September 15	Last day for students graduated in the Spring to order a transcript of their academic record and have the transcript fee waived.
