

**Checklist to enter KJAS  
District III competition:**

- Be sure that your school or club is a member of KJAS. If you don't know, ASK! Members are welcome to join throughout the year, although early registration is helpful.
- Go to <http://webs.wichita.edu/kjas>
- Find the District III on-line form.
  - Complete the information as it is requested.
  - Make sure you type in the e-mail addresses correctly.
  - You can cut and paste your abstract into the form. **IT MUST BE UNDER 300 WORDS!**
- When you are sure you have everything entered correctly, choose submit.
- Print **THREE** copies of the form. Two are for you to include as the front page of your papers to be turned in on or before April 9, the other one is for your teacher.
- Copy the mentor statement and include it in your papers as well. (So you need 2 of these)
- Give a copy of your form to and \$10 to your teacher. \$5 is for registration, the other \$5 is for a t-shirt.

The money will be sent by your teacher to the district directors. Teachers, please send to:

- The on-line form **MUST** be completed and submitted by midnight, Friday, February 20, 2009. Registration fees must be received by the district directors by the following Friday, February 27, 2009.
- Two copies of your research paper must be to the district directors by April 9<sup>th</sup>, 2009. You will want to have these to your teacher a week before this (April 2). Papers should be 12 point font, double-spaced, and stapled together. Report covers and binders are **not** recommended.
- Practice presenting your paper, then practice some more, then practice again. Be comfortable presenting in front of others. It is recommended to practice in front of a mirror, your parents, and even your pet...the more you practice, the better you are!
- Be at **Shawnee Mission South** High School on April 18th, 2009 by 10 am. You are encouraged to dress nicely and stay for all student presentations. Judges may ask you questions, so be prepared to answer them.
