



## KJAS JUDGES GENERAL INFORMATION SHEET DISTRICT MEETING

1. The score sheet can be filled out regarding the report to include comments, or comments can be made directly on the student's paper. *Please be constructive in your comments.*
2. Please question the participants at the end of their ten (10) minute presentation to determine the student's comprehension of the project. The goal is to have students know how to do science from start to finish and understand what they are doing. *Any criticism should be given in a constructive manner.*
3. The high school and middle school students may be mixed during presenting, please judge them accordingly. Their grade level will be indicated on their abstract and/or information sheet. Grades 9-12 are considered to be high school grades and 6-8 middle or junior high school grades.
4. Students who are judged Superior (Blue Ribbon) at the district meetings are automatically invited to present at the State Meeting on the first Thursday in May.
